Durham BRASS Festival Design your own Trombone Competition

Durham BRASS Festival have teamed up with the instrument maker pBone to offer children across County Durham the opportunity to “design their own” trombone. We are looking for children to create really eye catching designs – They don’t need to be brass related, so long as they stand out from the crowd. We have two age categories, 5 – 11 years and 12 – 18 years. One winner will be selected from each age category resulting in 2 winning entries. Each of the winners will receive a free pBone trombone featuring their design. The winners will be selected by our panel of judges. Entries must be the pupils’ original work, but children can use any media or materials they like to create their design. Collaborative entries can be submitted under a group name if the collaboration is between children within the same age category. We can also accept digital entries. This can either be a design created using a digital design or drawing programme, or a scanned in image
